

Dora L. Small School Welcomes March Madness 2018!

Join your friends for a series of exciting activities where you will learn something new, or perfect a talent you already have, and have loads of fun! Together with Small School parents and community members, the PTA is excited to offer these great opportunities during the month of March.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Supervision will be provided between 3:05 – 3:20 for enrolled students before classes begin.
- Pickup is promptly at the end of each class.
- Transportation is not provided

REGISTRATION

You may choose as many activities for your child(ren) as you wish, but due to limited class sizes, there is no guarantee that your child will be enrolled in all.

- **Indicate your child's 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc. choice on the registration form.**
- Attempts will be made to accommodate each child's first choice whenever possible; otherwise enrollment is via a lottery system. Submission of the registration form does not guarantee enrollment.
- **Consider choosing more than one class in order to increase the chances that your child will be enrolled in at least one of these.**
- **If you select more than one class, please indicate the MAXIMUM number of classes you wish your child to be enrolled in.** For example, you may make 4 or 5 selections, indicating 1st, 2nd, 3rd choice etc., but you may only want your child to enroll in a total of just two classes. Again, making more selections will increase the chances of your child getting into at least one class.
- **Remember that we will do our best to accommodate everyone, but making more than one selection does not guarantee enrollment.**
- Submit a separate registration form for each student by **Friday, February 16th**, but do not include any payment at this time.
- Submit your completed form(s) in an envelope marked "March Madness".
- Late forms will be returned unopened.
- You will be notified by email or phone confirming registration the week of February 19th.

PAYMENT

- Each class will cost \$10 per class, per student.
- Total payment for all classes will be due on the first day your child has a class – Please do not submit payment with registration form.
- Financial assistance is available. If your child wishes to participate, but the fee presents a hardship, a small discretionary fund has been established by the PTA to offer assistance. Please indicate on the registration form that you would like assistance and we will contact you about this.
- Class fees will be used to pay for supplies for these programs and to support future PTA programs and events.

CHEMISTRY CLUB EXPERIMENTS (Grades 3-5; Class size limited to 8)

USM Chemistry Club members

Each student will get to participate in a few fun hands-on science activities, including a water-lock experiment, which uses sodium polyacrylate (a water-lock polymer) to make water so thick it won't pour; psychedelic milk, a simple experiment using milk, food coloring, and dish soap; and an experiment with lycopodium powder (a moss spore actual found in ice cream) which enables you to put your hand in water without getting wet! Also, each student will get to make their own slime that they may take home with them in a little bag.
